LEVY ELECTION – GENERAL and BUILDING RESERVE
May 7, 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the undersigned Clerk of School District 14A of Phillips County, State of Montana, that pursuant to **two (2) resolutions** adopted by the Board of Trustees of said school district on **April 4, 2019**, an election of the qualified electors of School District 14A of Phillips County, Malta, Montana will be held on **Tuesday, the 7th day of May, 2019** by mail ballot for the purpose of voting on the question of whether the Board of Trustees of School District 14A of Phillips County, Montana shall be authorized to make the following levies:

General Fund:

A levy of approximately **3.77 mills** to raise the sum of **twenty-eight thousand five hundred eighty-one dollars and sixty-eight cents (\$28,581.68)** for the purpose of providing funds for general education expenses of the District beginning July 1, 2019.

Building Reserve Fund:

A levy of approximately **13.18 mills** to raise the sum of **one hundred thousand dollars and no cents (\$100,000.00) per year for five (5) years, for a total amount of five hundred thousand dollars and no cents (\$500,000.00)** for the purpose of general maintenance and upkeep of District Facilities and Grounds.

Ballots may be returned to the following location, at the following times:

- **Location Prior to Election Day:** Malta High School Central Office, 1 High School Lane S 9 W, Malta MT and
Hours: M-TH 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM, F 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM
- **Location on Election Day:** Malta High School Central Office, 1 High School Lane S 9 W, Malta MT and
Hours: 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM

A qualified registered elector who will be absent from the district during the time the election is being conducted may: a) vote in person in the election administrator's office as soon as the ballots are available and until noon the day before the ballots are scheduled to be mailed; b) make a written request, signed by the applicant and addressed to the election administrator, that the ballot be mailed to an address other than the address that appears on the registration card. The district clerk/election administrator's office is located at Malta High School Central Office, 1 High School Lane S 9 W, Malta MT.

If you miss the regular registration deadline (30 days prior to the election), you may still register for the election by showing up at the county election office up to and including on election day. Between noon and the close of business on the day before election day, you may complete and submit a voter registration card, but you will need to return to the district voting location on election day to pick up and vote a ballot. The county election office is located at the Phillips County Courthouse, 314 S 2nd Ave W, Malta MT.

This is a mail ballot election. Late registrants (after April 8, 2019) may obtain a mail ballot from the office of the District Clerk located at 1 High School Lane S 9th St W, **until 12:00 noon on Monday, May 6, 2019 or between the hours of 8 AM and 8 PM on Election Day.**
